One prize will be awarded for each continent as well as another prize for the best project submitted by a participant within the Lombardy region (Italy).

Evaluation Criteria

Projects will be evaluated by an independent international jury of high profile experts who recognise excellence in work-life conciliation.

The jury will assess each project based on the following specific criteria:

- Employee participation in each phase
- Area/areas of intervention
- Extent of initiatives carried out
- Number or percentage of beneficiaries
- Long-term duration
- Project innovation
